



Akin and ICF Host ‘Powering Progress: Decoding FERC Order No. 1920’

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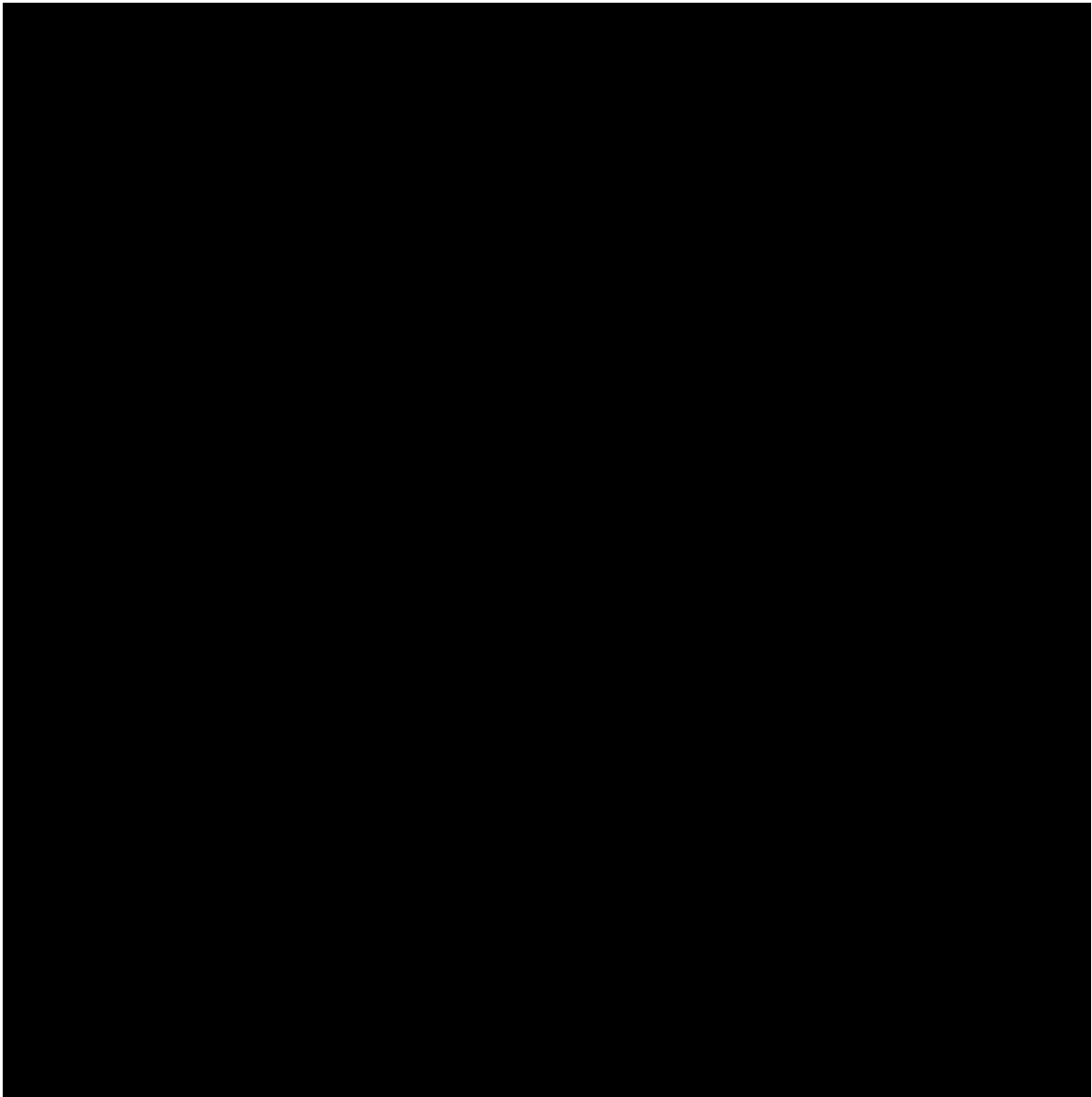
